



Itinerary Porto Ercole – Amalfi Coast

Day 1 – Porto Ercole to Giglio Island and Giannutri Island (2h30m sailing)

Embark at Porto Ercole in Tuscany at 12:00 p.m., and sail to the Giglio Island (1h30m cruising) where we will serve lunch and guests can swim in crystal waters afterwards. In the afternoon we will cruise to Giannutri Island (1h sailing). In the evening enjoy a special welcome dinner on board. Overnight

Day 2 – Giannutri Island to Anzio and Palmarola (11h30m sailing)

Very early sail from Giannutri at 5:00 am towards Anzio (8h30m cruising). Breakfast will be served at guests preferred time while sailing. We will get to Anzio around 1:30 pm when we will serve lunch aboard Satori or guests may prefer a local restaurant with a view. In the afternoon we will cruise to Palmarola (3h sailing). Aperitivo and dinner on Satori at sunset. Overnight.

Day 3 & 4 –Palmarola to Ponza (1h30m sailing)

Palmarola Island is the most western island of the Pontine Archipelago. We suggest you visit Punta Tramontana, from where you can admire a very beautiful bay called "The Cathedral" because of its cliff falling vertically to the sea and the big bays remind of that image.

Ponza island is fringed by inlets and coves. Enjoy Cala Inferno, Ansa dello Schiavone, Cala di Feola e Cala dell'Acqua Here you will find the natural pools, excavated by the sea in the tufa stone. Cala di Lucia Rosa: this coastline is particularly beautiful and is characterized by

a series of grottoes and rocks. Chiaia di Luna: from this marvelous beach you can reach the town of Ponza walking through a tunnel excavated by the ancient Romans. Ponza is a true jewel, and you can also enjoy dinner in one of the most known restaurants.

Day 4 – Ponza Island to Ventotene Island and Ischia (4h30 sailing)

Guests will enjoy a morning swim and breakfast aboard Satori before heading to Ventotene (2h cruising) for lunch. Ventotene is a beautiful island and perfect for scuba diving, if it's an activity guests would like to enjoy. After lunch we will cruise to Ischia (2h30m sailing) where aperitivo and dinner will be served in front of the castle in the eastern side on western Ischia at sunset. Overnight

Day 5 – Ischia to Procida and Capri (3h sailing)

After breakfast, we will sail to Procida. It is one of the best places in southern Italy to enjoy a relaxing and unique day out at sea. We will then head to Capri.

Arriving in Capri you will enjoy Cala di Maternania, Cala Ventroso, the White Grotto, the Green Grotto and the most famous Blue Grotto. Enjoy the swim and relax and a lovely lunch. You can't miss a nice a glamorous aperitivo at the internationally known Piazzetta di Capri (the main square). Overnight in Marina Piccalo.

Day 6 – Capri to Amalfi and Minori (2h30m sailing)

After breakfast, we will sail to Amalfi. Amalfi has had a glorious history as a maritime republic. The hub of the historic center is Piazza del Duomo, in front of the dramatic 11th century St. Andrew's cathedral with its Arab-influenced facade. The piazza is clustered with outdoor cafes and exclusive boutiques – perfect for whiling away a few hours after you've admired the stunning Baroque interior of the cathedral, decorated with bronzes and mosaics.

Amidst the stunning cliffs and azure waters of the Amalfi Coast lies a hidden gem, the beautiful town of Minori, UNESCO World Heritage Site. One of its most captivating things to do in Minori is to visit the Villa Romana e Antiquarium. This historical Roman Villa was accidentally discovered in 1934 and rediscovered after a flood wreaked havoc on Minori in 1954. Overnight in Minori.

Day 7 – Minori to Positano and Cetara (2h20m sailing)

After breakfast, we will sail Positano (1h cruising) where guests will enjoy lunch. Positano and Ravello are among the most aesthetic towns in the Mediterranean. The buildings clamber up the green mountain side away from the beach, climbing high and impressively above the sea level.

In the afternoon we will head to Cetara for aperitivo and dinner aboard Satori at sunset, and overnight.

Day 8 – Cetara to Marina d'Arechi to disembark by 12noon

After enjoying breakfast aboard Satori in beautiful Cetara, we will sail to Marina d'Arechi for disembarking.
